

Leave a legacy

Whatever your decision about the type of legacy to leave, our advice is always that you should use a solicitor to write or change your Will.

What do I need to do?

If you want to leave a legacy to the Rudolf Steiner School Kings Langley, you will need to have it written into your Will. If you already have a Will, this can be done simply by a solicitor adding a 'codicil' (an amendment to your Will). It is important to write out the schools full name, including the words Kings Langley in our title and our registered charity number 311027, otherwise your legacy could, mistakenly, be directed elsewhere.

Our fundraising coordinator will be very pleased to discuss how a legacy will help. You might have a cash legacy in mind, or you might be attracted to the idea of leaving a share of your estate (which can be more appropriate if you're not sure how much your assets will be worth).
